

ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER
ORDER REGARDING ELECTRONIC FILING

Effective January 4, 2016, all licensed attorneys must submit all new cases and documents within new or existing cases for filing with the District Court of Riley and Clay County, Kansas, utilizing the Kansas Courts Electronic Filing System. Attorneys utilizing the system should acquaint themselves with and follow Kansas Supreme Court Order No. 268. All local rules presently in effect continue to apply to all cases and documents filed through the e-filing system.
